unmounted drill, and the rest
of the morning in Semaphore
and buzzer practice.

I hope you won't stay in Chi.
very long as I am anxious
to get that photo of you.

I am going to get me a
new pocket Kodak if I
ever get out of that condition,
known as badly bent. It
has just been a month since
I enlisted at Jefferson Barracks.
I wish I knew where I
will be Sept. 20th. I sure
would like to come home for
a day about the first of
the month. Well I don't
feel much like writing tonight.
I hope you will get Sunday's
letter OK. If you don't — tell me.
