Another guard we get is at the Leavenworth City terminal bridge. This is the only bridge crossing the Missouri River near here and it is used by troop trains. Each end is guarded and no vehicles or persons with packages are allowed to cross without first being searched for explosives. I went on guard Sunday afternoon at 4:00 o'clock. Each man has two hours on and four off so I had 4-6 & 10-12 P.M. on the Kansas end of the bridge. It was pretty lively between 10-11 Sunday night.
