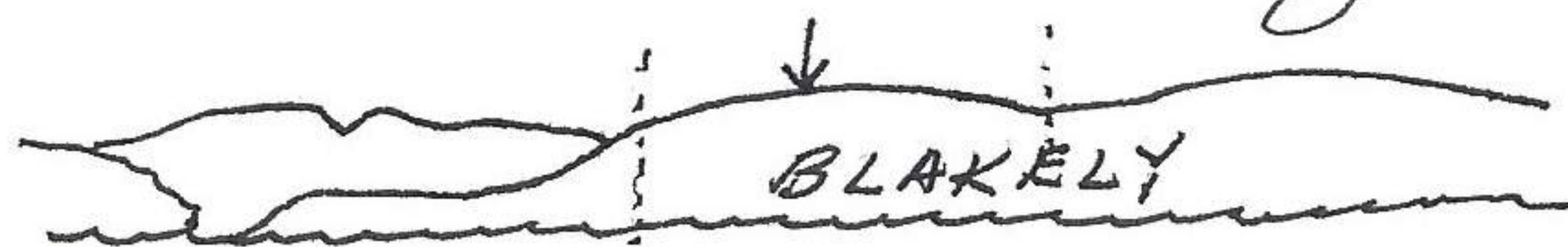


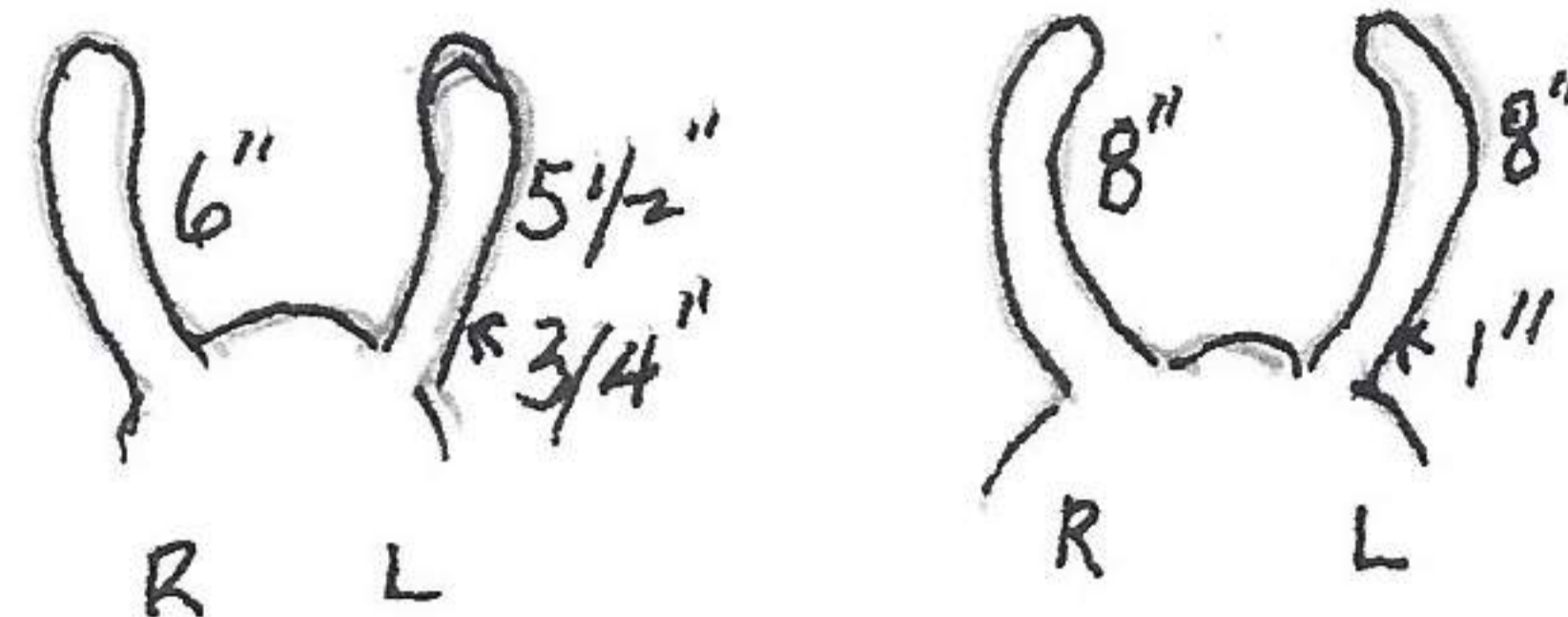

Mule deer at Bee House this AM include 4 ♂ and 5 ♀. Two of the males had similar antlers. Within the mule deer herd, the fastest things on deer feet are the new fawns. They race around the hillside at full speed.



Swallows feeding young swallows outside ⁿ nesting box.
Observed a rufous hummingbird fly SE to out of site (over sound).
An eastern gray squirrel Sciurus carolinensis was killed in road by car at Graces Episcopal Church on Humphrey Head.
The ⁿ nesting box of violet green swallow received nesting material for most of the day.

6:10 P.M. 6 rufous hummingbirds at feeder at Bee House.

June 3, 1994

4:50 A.M. a small myotis-like bat arrived at Bee House roosting site. It buzzed the entrance 3 times before entering.

5:00 A.M. violet-green swallows active.

4 mule deer fawns with adults at feeders.
