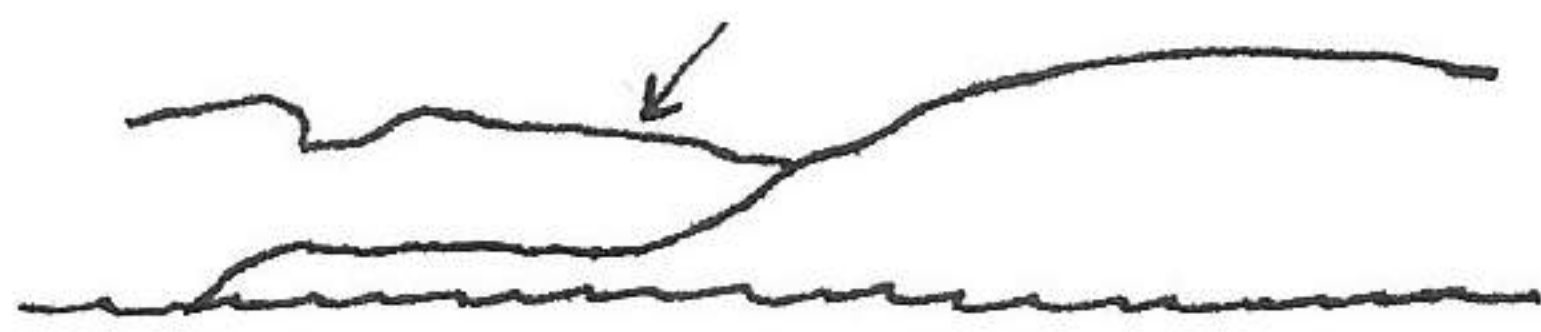


Informant said a young helpless crow had fallen from its nest on his property on Lopez Island.

Any abnormality of flight or behavior causes 4-6 violet-green swallows to hover over problem area. This is particularly true of awkward flight of a young swallow first leaving nesting box. It is difficult to determine behaviorism of these swallows.

Turkey vulture flying over field corner of Cross^{road} and Fisherman's Bay Road.

On E side of causeway at South Fisherman's Bay Lagoon noted 15 Caspian tern in one resting group.

marsh n Hummel Lake now all green in cattails except dead heads of last year.

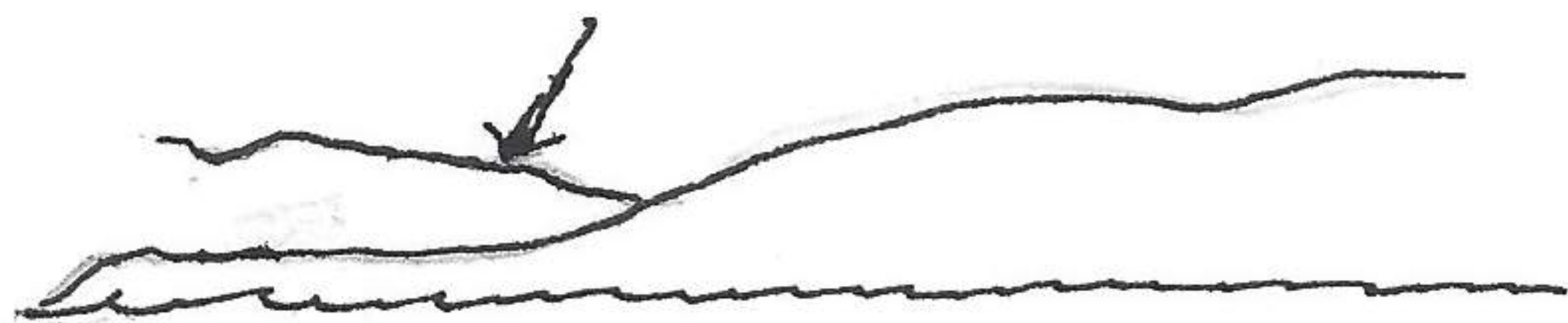
Catchment basin now all green.
