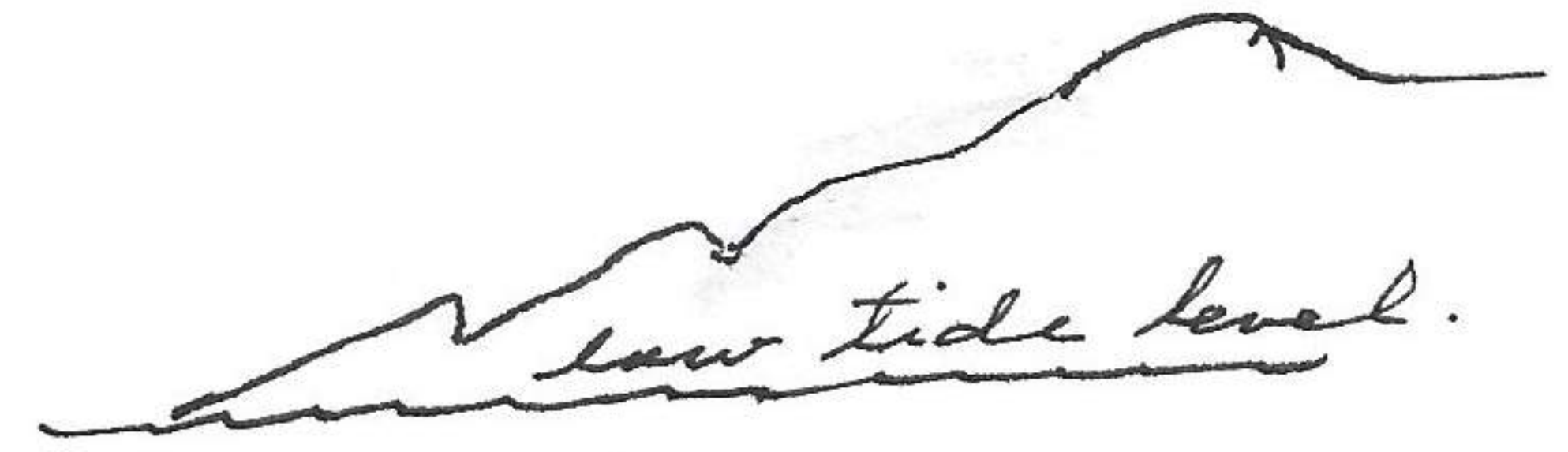


July 25, 1994

First violet-green^(ad.) swallow active 5:56 A.M. at nesting box
Rufous hummingbirds. 2 or 3 today but greatest number have
left.

At W side^S Fisherman Bay Lagoon (W of causeway) observed:
8 great blue heron, 23 glaucous-winged gulls, 7 Herrmanns gulls
mixed with glaucous-winged. On E side causeway: 38
glaucous-winged gulls (10 with dark primaries),

at Leichen Point low tide profile thus:
Sent gray-ruffed grouse article to
Brown, editor Trumpeter newsletter.



July 26, 1994

2 rufous hummingbirds observed today, sugar level stabilized
violet green swallows in evening. Their main feeding times
are early A.M. + late P.M.

July 27, 1994

Violet-green swallows active of S nesting box. For most
of the evening the adults feed young at entrance.

House finches spend considerable time feeding in madrone tree,
1/4" sugar taken by rufous hummingbirds.

The twin fawns are approx 2/3 body mass of a single fawn.

July 28, 1994

Rufous hummingbird more active (3) today than previous week.
Violet green-swallows active today at nesting boxes
