

Observed these slides from about $1/2$ way up the dugway leading from Aspen Grove toward bud valley. Salamander lake. On the dugway observed several skippers. At one of the springs in main part of the Grove found both the mayflies, ^{larvae} and caddis fly larvae as well as many collembola. On return trip saw another snow shoe rabbit at Aspen and another *Eutamias* (sp) below aspen. Used skis from Stewart's flat on up & return.

3/20/39

English Sparrows copulating at home. Provo, Utah Co. Ut.

3/22/39

Mourning cloaks butterfly at home. (255 E 1st S) Provo, Utah Co.

3/22/39

Bees busy around maple trees on campus. Solitaire feeding in yard at lower B.Y.U. campus.

3/27/39

Left home 6:10 A.M. for Provo River at end of delta S.W. of Provo. about 12 W. 10 north. Arrived at swinging bridge 6:45. 7:20 Sun up. 7:40 Breakfast through. 8:05 went to top of delta, hence west to tracks, hence south across bridge, back to grounds at swinging bridge arriving at 9:00. The birds observed were robins singing at 6:45, Sparrow hawk, House Finch, singing at 6:15, Red-wing blackbirds (sp) flying north in flocks at 6:40 A.M., Eng. Sp, Kinglet, L. Sp Towhee, T.T. Chickadee, Song sparrows, wrens, pheasants, 4 mallards, meadowlark, Killdeer, frog (*Rana pipiens*) calling.

3/29/39

Sparrow hawk at 5th N & 3 east in Provo. Flying about 300 feet in air and calling vigorously. Heard the sparrow hawk one week earlier in the same vicinity which would be first record of the year.

4/1/39

Birds observed in same vicinity as 3/27/39 but selective observation. 1 flock of blackbirds, probably red-wings flying north. 50 Grackles calling nervously (?) or anxiously in trees near river. They were flying from one cottonwood to another.
