It is possible that the suction keeps body below, it would take six days of rowing to return to Moab up the Grand. The best way to arrange this return trip would be to have a motor boat run down from Moab to junction & tow your boat back. It is also possible to pack out and abandon boat. Would take about one month of deliberate travel to make complete collection of Labyrinth & its lateral canyons.

5-6-39

Collected fossils 5-6-39 from West Canyon about 3 miles up canyon where canyon make w. trend and 200' up n. trend - my canyon from black clay mine. Pennsylvanian in age. Beds strike n 40° W. dip 56° N. E.

5-14-39

Sid Bayle and Red Biddleph and myself made canoe trip from mouth Provo River to Mud Lake-Utah Lake tunnel & return. Nothing unusual. Few Cormorants, Pelicans & ducks.

5-16-39

Trip up south end of mt. Timpanogos. Solitary trip remaining two days on mountain. Left Tom Lessford at the Fishermans home in Provo Canyon. He was to return two days from now and pick me up again. With a heavy pack on back started up ridge directly north of the Fishermans Home proper. As I worked up the base of the ridge could hear both the Song Sparrow and Chipping Sparrow below in the pasture along the Provo River.

Left at 3:25 P.M. as I worked up ridge recorded the occurrence of the animal forms. At 3.35 had recorded 5 Sceloporus g.g. (?)

Followed along the very crest of this ridge. At 3.35 saw Citellus v. utah feeding in maple & oak leaves at base of maple trees. It ran up the ridge. 3.42 Cit v. utah moths.

3:42 Summer passed to west and calling. Spurred Towhee calling below.

3:50 Summer calling & one Scelop.

3:53 Sparrow Hawk. 4:00 2 Sceloporus. g.g. These lizards were all of the species gramm as far as I could tell. 4:03 3 Salap. among oak leaves on ground. 4:05 Summer to west. Now near top of springs that are found to the west on ridge slope. Few Sceloporus, several Swifts & Swallows in air. 5:15 Fresh gopher diggings. 5:16 two Sceloporus. At this point counted 15 Sceloporus in 8 minutes time on ridge. 4:30 1 buck with velvet and in very poor conditions. Hair shabby and ribs protruding. Spurred Towhee singing
