Wilmer and I left Pravo at 3:30 P.M with the intention of establishing our expedition station at West Canyon in Cedar Valley. In crossing Cedar Valley on the regular road to Cedarfort and at a point about half way across valley observed numerous horned larks, generally in pairs but ranging in numbers from 1 to 10. They were in such numbers that as we drove along they were seen to be continually flying up as we advanced along. The wind was blowing furcifully from the north and regardless of the position of the larks whether on the south side of road or on the north side, they would consistently leave and fly directly into the wind. At a point where road turns north to mouth of West Canyon, observed 4 Sparrow Hawks together. Kangaroo rats incidence by numerous dead bodies in the road. These rats are found in a more or less sandy situation and associated with the rocky tongues and associated juniper trees near by.
