research area A. 8-2-39 between 6:00 and 7:00 P.M.

This series of mammals do not represent all the mammals
collected from research area A. 8-2-39 but are representative at
least. The others were indicated in original catch however.
or are recorded later on. If I could not measure and
mount certain mammals and if time was pressing so
that all of the days could ^{could} not be handled, they were placed
in air-cooled ice box for the following day when they
would be included in with other mammals but exact recorded
as to date, area, etc were indicated. After supper, set about
a dozen traps on south hillside and steep exposure among
maples and took sample for future trapping among the maples
bordering the canyon. Here the ground is dry without much
vegetation and the exposed roots of the maples make ideal
places for *Peromyscus*. These traps were strung 30 feet up
hillside right at Cabin station. All in close proximity to each
other. Baited with oat meal. This is research area no.
A. 8-3-39. and will be used as sample area for present.

Last check on research area A. 8-2-39. at 9:00 P.M. without
results. Moon up at 9:37 P.M. in eastern horizon. Rays
of light effected our area at 9:37 exactly. Bed early with
prospects of a good day tomorrow. It has been clear all
day, very hot but slight breeze in canyon. Wilmer has
been in field today collecting many interesting lizards.
He finds an apparent lack of snakes of any description
here.
