The weather during the day was overcast until about noon. Clouds as clouds until evening. Overcast at 8:00 P.M., clear at 9:00 P.M. Cooler this morning than usual. At 10:00 P.M. temp 65° F. I bought set addition line to research area A-8-4-39 of 16 traps. These are recorded in original description of this area. Wilmer placed some Curmees (immature measuring 69 mm. in length) in formaldehyde. The were suspended as if they had repelling oil film on body. Yesterday the adult Curmees was placed in a killing jar of formaldehyde at the same time a Sceloporus was placed in same jar. The Sceloporus graciosus graciosus died in about 10 minutes while the Curmees endured for 15 hours!! Bed fairly early - 11:00 P.M!! (see measurements of this evening catch in the 8-6-39 notes)

8-6-39 Station 1, West Canyon, Rhodes Cabin, Utah Co., Up at 6:30 A.M. weather at 6:50 A.M. looks as if rain may be due. Temperature then 66° F. At 7:05 A.M. started to rain. Temperature at 7:50 = 61° F.
