Series IV Similar to no III and a continuation. Trap from no-58 to 62.

Series V In cliffs and at base. From trap 63 to 120. Generally placed at base of cliff or among rocks adjacent to cliffs.

Series II On ridge of soft white granular dirt. Artemisia scarce and 1/2 foot high to 2' high. Rocky to the extent of 90%. The 2 traps were set near some small mounds of dirt that had been excavated by either mice or Dipodomys.

Series III Traps 123-131 in gulch on south side of ridge. Dirt sandy and loose, juniper & Artemisia large. About 200' south from top of ridge.
