Wilmer in field this morning from 9:00 A.M. to 12 A.M. and re-  
ports collecting 5 *Sceloporus bi-seriatus* from cliffs on north  
side of Pass. He observed 2 others. Collected one *Crotaphytus*  
*wislegizine* with a grasshopper in stomach. Males & females  
of *bi-seriatus* in equal numbers. I have observed several  
*Cnemidophorus* near camp and have observed as many as 7  
*Crotaphytus wislegizine* at one time, that is on one trip through  
*artemesia* to collect the Antelope Chismunk. They are very  
wild and once they get started they don't stop! On one occasion  
I approached a *Sceloporus graciosus* and placed my hand  
near it without any fear on its part but when I placed the  
end of the gun near it it ran as if wild and did not run  
into protection of the *artemesia* as they usually would do but  
ran in clearing without stopping and at full speed. With others  
tested with the gun barrel found that you could not scare  
them into the *artemesia* but they purposely stay clear of any  
brush or shrub & kept in the openings. I wonder and truly  
believe that they think the barrel is a snake and to hide  
in brush would be only death to them. Their greatest escape  
is rapidly running at full speed without stopping. Today the  
sky is clear, little wind & hot day. Weather the last 3 days:

- 12<sup>th</sup> Clear, hot windy all day.  
13<sup>th</sup> Clear in morning. Stormy & winds & slight rain in afternoon.  
14<sup>th</sup> Stormy all day particularly in afternoon.  
15<sup>th</sup> Clear in morning with storm clouds about noon.
