no. 25-8-27-39 is also a typical section along the route showing the association with the research area no A-8-21-39. A detailed and specific description of the research area A-8-22-39 are as follows:

1. to 4 at entrances to holes on sands of dune at the extreme southern terminal of the N. E. trending dune line. This set of traps is merely a continuation of research area A-8-21-39.

5-10 these traps were stretched across the intervening area between the two dune lines. Dirty packed and with a covering of brown moss and few small isolated weeds.

11-12 peripheral edge of dune line at hole.

13 entrance to hole.

14-16 Clearing on sands.
