- (82-9-5-39) *Peromyscus*. no tail, foot 19.5 - 14grs. testis 2 m.m. pelage dark greyish brown.

Temperature at 10:00 P.M. = 52° F Sky clear now after having rained from about 4 o'clock to 7 o'clock P.M. this afternoon.

9-7-39 Station 4, Timpooneche Basin Camp

Temperature at 8:30 A.M. = 52° F. Rained last night from 12 o'clock to 8:00 A.M. today then momentarily stopped and skies started to clear up but rain soon commenced again. At 9:00 A.M. a large boulder evidently dislodged at the classical rock slide to the east. It sounded as if there might be a little movement in higher portion of slide. Did not make early inspection of trap route because of the rain this morning but plan on going up as soon as the weather clear up. Since 8:00 A.M. it rained frequently with mist clouds lower than they have ever been since work on the mountain. at 12:00 rained good then stopped at 12:45 and mist clouds commenced to move up the mountain sides with blue spots in skies exposed. Temperature at 12:45 P.M. = 51° F. Little breeze last hour or so. Before going up into cirque today measured the remaining mammals of the 6th. also prepared them. They are as follows.
