(Extra notes of 9-8-39. while in cirque of that day made a reconnaissance trip up main trail to about the 4th terrace which is one of the main and broad terraces. From here follow east to main gulch and hence down the somewhat steep gulch. while on terraces to the picture no. 21-9-8-39

showing the nature of the upper portions of the research area established in cirque. The conifers on the left hand side of the picture shows the research area E-9-5-39. The portions of the other area also visible in the distance. also take another picture of the
