*Nycticorax nycticorax procelli* - 11 - singly only one adult.  
*Ardea herodias teganzai* - about 16 altogether  
*Anas p. platyrhynchos*  
*Mergus serrator* - prob. 30 all told  
*Branth canadensis leucoparia* - not the proper. Was  
 about a foot from mequense and comparison was rather  
 simple if not too much so. Really don't know the exact  
 species but that's my guess.  
*Pica pica udsonia*  
*Passerculus s. nevadensis*  
*Melospiza m. merrilli* - prob. diff subspecies down along here -  
 looked slightly different.  
*Anas regina shufeldti*  
*Rapides satrapa olivaceus*  
*Larus delawarensis*  
*Petron carolinensis* ? - 14  
*Oxyechus v. vociferans*  
*Coccyzus velox* ? probably -  
*Larus californicus* - possible - all such birds were imm.  
 and very wary giving me no good chance to identify properly.
