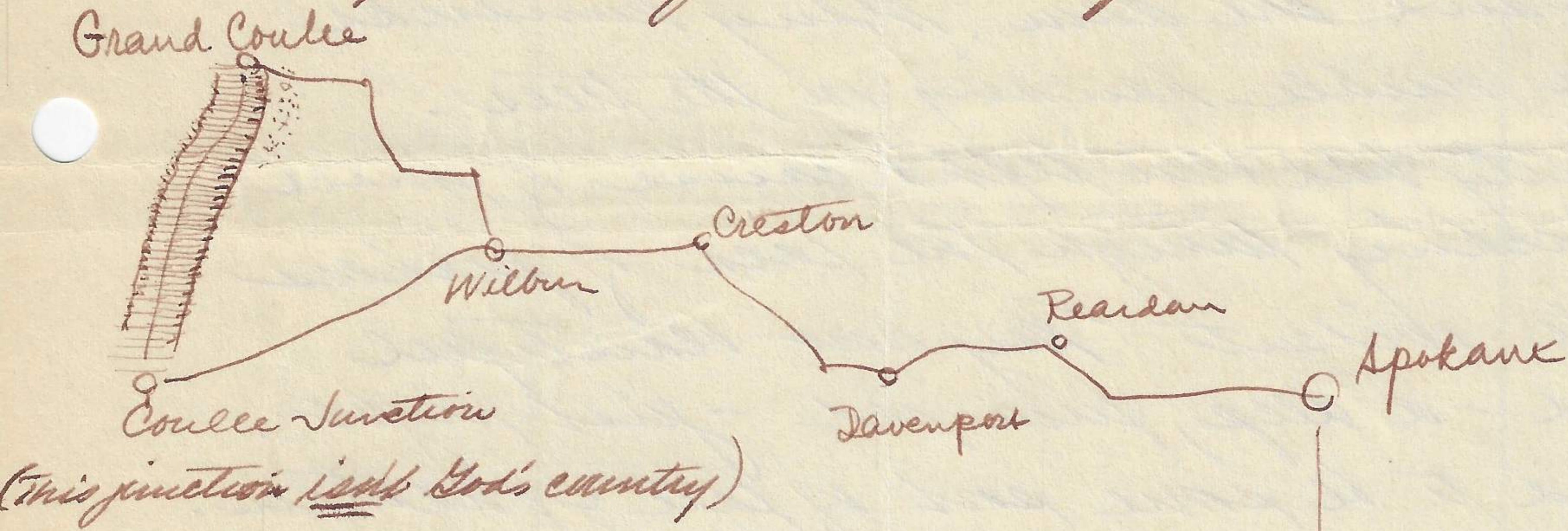


November 15, 1942
