

From late twilight for an hour or so after the geese were decidedly restless and called continually in south end of lake. This did not happen to such degree on other evenings during the same period of time, however, the unfavorable weather may have had something to do with this reaction. The high water made traversing of pasture impossible. Only knolls appeared above the ground. All lakes and ponds joined by wide inundated channels. The successional barrier of outer willows inundated. Only older willows above of water level. Sandpiper and flover habitat entirely obliterated; also evidence by lack of these birds.
