

Sand point, Bemark, Minneapolis, St Paul, Chicago, Murfrees-  
boro, Chattanooga, New Orleans, El. Pass, Yuma, Los Angeles,  
San Francisco, <sup>Oakridge</sup> Vancouver. Returned March 12, 1943. First  
Road Runner in <sup>Texas</sup> Alpine area, about 10 miles east, others at  
Yuma, Antelope herd near Alpine.

3/15/43

Leverick Creek from Rosseter Street to "O" Street. Three  
single *Otus asio kinnicatti* calling after dusk.

3/17/43

Ibid. *Salix* dominant bird, many singing and calling  
from tops of conifers. On return to Hospital flushed a  
robin from low hedge bordering private home which would  
indicate that possibly these birds found in tree tops earlier  
in evening changed their position to low bushy roasts.  
A noticeable lack of bird life with *Dendroica bicolor*,  
*Melospiza melodia morphna*, <sup>(1) *Icterus naevius naevius*</sup> Kinglet being represented.  
Return before late twilight so did not have chance to hear  
Owls. Time in field from 6:10 to 7:45 P.M.

3/21/43

Battleground and return via railroad route. Walked back,  
varying by traversing wooded sections adjacent to the rail-  
road grade. Birds and mammals observed. No approx.
