10-26-44. Picture (8-10-26-44) of the DEHING river, APO 689 with dugout boats moored to their respective home landings. Each family along the river edge has its own personal dock, which consists of nothing more than a stake to tie the boat. It is remarkable how few ducks one finds on this river or even in the entire area itself.

10-27-44. Picture 1-10-27-44 of DEHING river APO 689. Passing dugout. Framed with river bordering jungle. The broad hats the navigators use lend added interest to the picture. They are used frequently when on the river or during a rainy day. Boats propelled and guided by long bamboo prodding poles.

10-28-44 W side Lle Ning Rover, 2 mi. nnw margharetta, assam, Inclea. Collected 5 butterflies from jungle and savanna (see march 24,1947).
