11-6-44. Ivory statuettes generally described to identify and travelling from left to right: Lakshmi. Goddess of learning and prosperity. Krishna 9th incarnation of Vishnu. He is a popular and prominent Hindu God and is usually represented by playing the flute. He is figured in the Epic Mahabharata and seems to be rather popular with the young ladies. Budha Gautama Budha founder of Buddhism. He belonged to the warrior caste of Hindu but quite contrasting ideas as far as his religion was concerned. Jesus. Brahma. Shiva. Vishnu. Questionable as to identity (Vishnu only.) Vishnu is one of the three of the Trinity. He is much worshipped and denotes a power to preserve the oppressed from cruelty. There are ten incarnations of Vishnu each one representing a natural way of overcoming evil. Rama, Varmana and Krishna are notable examples of the incarnations of Vishnu. Ganesha The elephant god of Wisdom. Will try to describe these Gods in more detail at a later date but I think there is sufficient description to identify.
