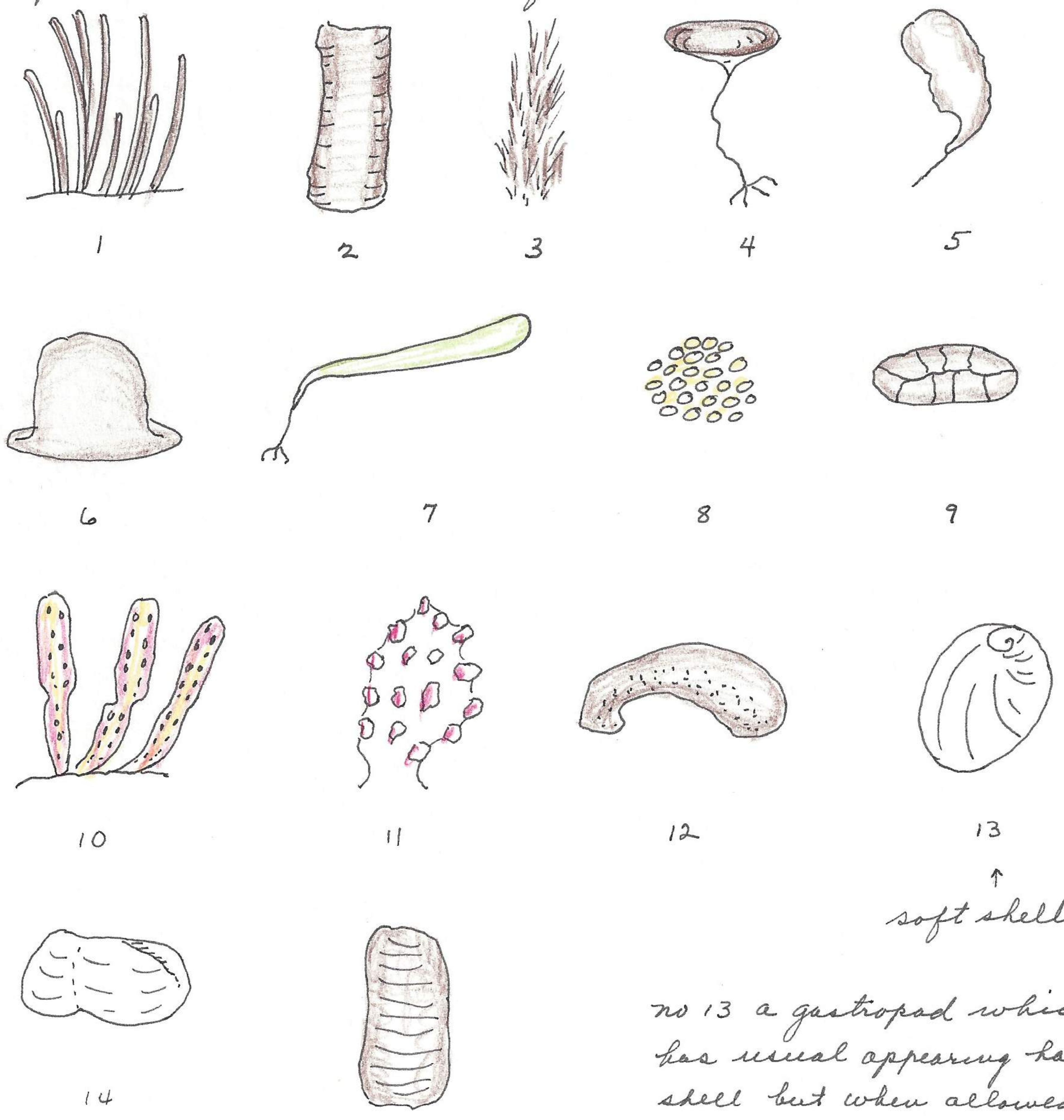


The blubber and grease was placed on top of bone pile so that it would soak down through the bone pile and create a saturated bone suitable for a cooking fire. The house proper was of logs, horizontally placed, or whale bone as supports and covered with sod. Only entrance to house through roof door as indicated.
