

Group of pictures taken in Payson Canyon near the Payson reservoir. Camped at the Forester Rangers Station near reservoir with Gaylord Gillies and Emmett Ireland, both of Provo. The series is mainly of the reservoir taken from different angles. Picture (1-6-20-28) was taken from the top of a conifer tree on hill at the north end of lake. Looking south with Nebo in distance. The trees in this area are predominately aspen with alies conular and Pseudo. sugo mixed. When trees are found they are very large, one conifer better than 5' through. The aspen are big, tall and crowded. Many forest birds are found here in unusual numbers. Oaks and maples on some east ridges. Springs in valleys with nice vegetation and willows. Found 3 bees nests. 2 in aspen and 1 in a large oak tree 18" in diameter. Shorebirds and salamanders around the different lakes. Many bear claw marks on aspen trees. marmot at station. no (2-6-20-28) same as above but on south side looking north. no (3-6-20-28) on knoll to south of reservoir looking north with Tooper mountain in background. The two areas at same altitude are contrasted here. no (4-6-20-28) from top of tree to north rim looking south across high area with Nebo in the distance. The mixed tree condition is clearly seen from here. no

(5-6-20-28) shows Nebo in the distance with a rocky ridge in foreground. Also near reservoir being N.E. of there. Three red-tail nest found while on stay at the ranger station.
