Left Provo at 6:00 A.M. in Sid's old model T. ford. Sky clear with moon directly above. Heber valley proved exceptionally cold in the open car so we stopped for a cup of coffee & a roll but remained only long enough for reestablishing circulation and then we were on our way again. Arrived at

Divide of Samels at 7 o'clock found the road in good condition with corn snow along the side reflecting in the sun. A few snow slides had penetrated the valley from the west side of canyon. Left car at divide and shouldered packs. Snow in good condition so were making better time than anticipated. Picture (1-2-3-37) was taken about half way as we started up thru the more wooded area. Camp was to be established as indicated. The long north trending ridge can be seen. It was on this ridge that we were to spend most of our time. Picture no (2-2-3-37) was taken without a string being merely a self taken exposure of my own shadow on the opposite side of a snow gully. Arrived at base of Strawberry peak at 12:40 P.M. made camp in small group of conifer tree just over brink of open field below peak as indicated in later picture. By 4:00 P.M. we were all set up and
