



1-2-13-37 - Early morning mood of Timpanogas from camp before light rarp were of sufficient strength to record properly.



2-2-13-37 Same as to left with light rarp more intense. The clouds now shrouding uppermost peaks.



3-2-13-37 - Scene of mt. Timp. from above camp. Snow in good sking condition.



1-2-14-37 - Ski slopes at head of Pole Canyon divide. Provo Peak and ridge in distance. North terminal of Cascade to left. The day started out like a warm July day so the fellows took advantage of the ultra violet rarp. Ruy, mark, Harry & Blaine from left to right.
