



Bat cave at Split Point on July 11, 1957 (just east of larger Cove at about 603 yds S and 225 yds W Lameshur Estate House) On July 14, I estimated 30 *Artibeus jamaicensis* inhabiting this cave. On July 15, only two were seen. This chimney type cave does not permit temperature variation and is fairly well lighted. These are the basic differences between the two caves.
