Circumnavigation of Utah Lake by Conae. Sidney Bayle and myself made the 5 day trip with the objective of checking upon the birds along the peripheral edges of the lake and the correlation of the fish eating forms with the likely and favorable fish habitats. The original objective was to include the execution of the following recording: Record of species, numbers, correlation of percent frequency with the time factor, flights, earliest and latest activity, weather log, water temperatures and depths, shoreline topography and vegetation, crosssections of shore lines and transects and possible associations. Each individual birds was to receive consideration as to time, location, flights and general activity. However, the first few miles thoroughly convinced me that the above procedure could not be carried out to our full expectations, simply because the manning of the conae demanded more time than had expected. At least I felt it would not be fair to skid my 50% of the conae propulsion, so reduced
