at 1:00 P.M. tested 22 seeds for possible poison. These seeds were from the ventriculi of six quail (see previous note) which were dead from virus pneumonia. At 3:00 P.M. 8 seeds had been eaten and the mouse was normal.

March 9, 1960

Placed skull of no 600307-5, Colinus, in dermestid jar. The dermestids have increased in size to almost adult stage and have burrowed into the prepared blocks of feed. In the last week they have appeared above the level of the food. Many cast skins in jar. Water in alcohol lamp, used for humidifier, about  $\frac{3}{5}$  gone.
