Today we made canoe trip to second portage from camp to east and also to river which flows N from Gobbos Lake. Fishing has been excellent at all of our camps, having at least one meal per day.

Aug 19, 1960

at 10:00 A.M. temp 70°F, water 72°F. Today still cloudy, partially clear this P.M. Thunderstorms (isolated) east & west of us from 6:00 P.M. to 10:00 P.M. Took several photos at Camp today:

- (600819-1) Annette by edge of canoe, clowning
- (600819-2) Jay and fish jumping out of H<sub>2</sub>O (N. pike)
- (600819-3) Chris on sleeping bags which were airing on rocks by camp.
- (600819-4) Lake and long log at edge
- (600819-5) Lichens, red berry etc.
- (600819-6) Birch, blue berry and a fern like plant.
- (600819-7) rapids with sunlight reflected.
- (600819-8) Annette washing dishes
- (600819-9) general camp area
- (600819-10) water lily pods were N. pike were caught.
- (600819-11) Birch + liverworts near camp
- (600819-12) across lake & to the SSW. Annette in foreground.
- (600819-13) water lily in lake

watched 2 mink near camp (30' from H<sub>2</sub>O), one small one being chased by a larger one. There was squealing sounds as if animals were breeding or fighting. Animals noted in the evening.

Temp 10:00 A.M. = 70°F, water 72°F. Left camp at 11:00 A.M. <sup>arrived</sup> Completed 18<sup>th</sup> portage <sup>and arrived</sup> by 12:05 P.M. and completed by 12:50 P.M.

This portage is thru cedar trees. Photo (600820-1) of the lower end of this portage. 600820-1a between <sup>2 portages at lunch</sup> arrived at 12<sup>th</sup> portage at 3:25 P.M. Canoeed thru rapids as waters were low. Photo (600820-2)
