600820-5 Camp with Chris at fire.

Aug 21, 1960

Fog this A.M., warm last night. At 9:30 A.M. air = 68°F, water 72°F. Jay caught walleye measuring 16 1/2 inches in total length. A common loon passed camp this A.M. Photos this A.M. are:

600821-1 Camp with canoes in foreground. This camp is at the gateway to the N. Kawishiki.

600821-2 Annette combing Pally's hair at camp.

600821-3 same as no 1. But may be double exposure. (N.G.)

Left camp at 9:45 A.M. to west up N. Kawishiki.

Photo 600821-4 of Chris & Jay in canoe with black forest & rock background. Continued west to 214 rd portage arriving at 11:50 A.M. Photo 600821-5 of Chris at Murphy Portage sign. Made four portage to get material across and completed haul & lunch by 5:00 P.M. The first trip of this portage with canoe took 45 minutes. Return trip 30 minutes. Organized parties can make this portage in one trip in 30 minutes. Water run east on east end of portage & west on west end of portage. Kawishiki River should not apply to the river running west. 600821-6 west end of 214 portage, Annette & Jay. Continued west to 17 rds portage & lowered canoe over rapids. 600821-7 showing Annette & Chris lowering canoe. Continued west and were across 10 rd portage by 6:30 P.M. Continued west to Battleship Rock arriving at 7:45 P.M.

Aug 22, 1960

Left Battleship Rock 10:50 arrived Voyageur Camp 11:50.

Left Voyageur Camp by car by 12:45 P.M. and with muleage at 78364 Continued east on highway <sup>no. 1</sup> to Superior Lake. Camped at 2 mi. N Gooseberry Falls.
