- (26) Fishing gear: ^{+ spinning reels} 2 poles, 1 extra line, 6 spoons, 6 surface, steel leader, 12 swivels, 12 hooks, grease & oil, 1 net, 1 hook remover, 1 fish stringer.
 - (27) tents should be light & high
 - (28) sleeping bags should be lightweight.
 - (29) misc. material in duffle bags
 - (30) tarp to cover food
 - (31) 2 SOS pads per day & protect from H₂O or powdered in food
 - (32) Camera equipment in H₂O-proof container
 - (33) cardboard boxes will disintegrate if wet.
 - (34) 2 portage a day is sufficient, occasionally 2 days at same camp.
 - (35) leave sleeping bags in tent when packing
 - (36) air sleeping bags every 3rd day.
 - (37) carry light-weight binoculars
 - (38) retire at night before mosquitoes become too active.
 - (39) Islands are better camping spots because of fewer mosquitoes, more breeze, better view in general.
 - (40) Camp site should have good dock for loading equipment into canoes and a rock shelf at water edge for washing dishes
 - (41) Get water from windward side of island or at center of lake
 - (42) Carry canoe on yoke for 100' or until tired & then change with second individual or carry canoe at waist height with ropes & stick. 
 - (43) Emergency equipment should include: wire, long nosed pliers, screwdriver (small for reels), hacksaw blade, small file, mirror, whistle, needles, thread, band-aids, pain reliever, thermometer.
 - (44) soap should float
 - (45) turn canoe over for table at camp.
 - (46) carry strong rope for portaging.
 - (47) use chairs for pack boards & carry equip in duffle bags
 - (48) carry extra large plastic bags
 - (49) Have a good water-proof watch & a thermometer
 - (50) butter should be carried in a closed container like a glass jar.
 - (51) 17' canoe handles better on water & in wind plus more room for carrying equipment.
 - (52) keep water clean by properly excluding all human wastes (feces, urine, sputum) from ^{lake} water.
 - (53) Chart all vegetation and recheck every 10 years. Stabilize level of water. Publish book on vegetation, birds, mammals, fish etc
