



checked activity of black swift entering roosting chimney at the Centennial School. Last night 350 or more birds entered the chimney. Tonight 561 birds entered the chimney as indicated above. Information correlated with Oct 3 observation is as follows:

- 6:03 P.M. 9 birds in area, some flying by chimney but not entering chimney.
- 6:06 P.M. 18 in area but generally dispersed - not over chimney.
- 6:09 P.M. 5 over chimney but passing by
- 6:10 P.M. 30 in area around chimney - first bird entered
- 6:11 P.M. 30 in loose groups away from chimney
- 6:12 P.M. 60 in area, numbers increasing
- 6:13 P.M. circular motion starting above chimney
- 6:15 P.M. 200 in area
- 6:17 P.M. all birds left area but returned 1/2 min later - few birds than when they left.
- 6:20 P.M. One planet has been visible
- 6:23 P.M. good circular motion
- 6:30 P.M. only one planet visible - no stars discernible.
- 6:33 P.M. few stars faintly visible.

Day clear, in evening a few clouds in west, full moon on horizon in east at time of observation. Birds always entered or approached chimney from the west.
