3-5-2-37. John on Elk Peak. Distant Cascades and points south Stewart cirques in foreground capped with rugged peaks above. 11:00 A.M.  $\frac{1}{25} \times 20$  on Verichrome. (see p. 38.1 for enlargement)



1-5-2-37. Divide at Elk Peak with perceptuous cirque walls in the background. Winter still much in evidence.



4-5-2-37 Terraced scene from Elk Peak looking west into Emerald Lake and glacier valley. 11:00 A.M. Clear sky  $\frac{1}{25} \times 18$  on Verichrome.



2-5-2-37 Another view of Elk Peak with similar setting as above. Confining cirque wall lend a most unusual setting for the picture. About 10:00 A.M. Clear day  $\frac{1}{25} \times 18$  with Verichrome film.
