It is very unusual that this area does not support *Sigmodon hispidus*, unless they have been killed by the recent low temps of the last month. This could account for the extensive use of the area and at one time in the near past (within last month) and the relatively few mammals captured this date. The most remarkable change is the extensive use of runways on the hill field and the few mammals captured in traps. *Microtus* gone and *Peromyscus* encroaching.
