Eagle nest in Grove Creek on mt. Tamponogus. First nest, middle position at loose rock cliff on south rim of canyon. Nest consisted of a entire upper surface of Douglas fir boughs completely covering the nest. The green boughs are superimposed on last years dry structure of old mahogany branches, artemisia, douglas fir and oak. Skunk cabbage stalks and a paper like hornet nest material resting on edge of present cup on east side. Nest faces north. Excrement below nest on SW side. Food items found at nest are: male *Autospermophilus g. utah*, 1 young marmot with hair picked off of leg, 1 male gopher, 1 marmot head with eyes and brains eaten.
