Investigated trap line of last night's setting. It is located 2 blocks north of the newly constructed erosion dam at mouth of Grove Creek. This area is a marmot colony on a round knoll bordered by cultivated fields to the west and sagebrush flats to the north and south and a continuation of the mountain slope to the east. The vegetation is dominantly sagebrush with oak trees represented near the den proper. The hillside is a typical west exposure with little vegetation between the sagebrush. The ground is dry and rocky. The den is a slightly elevated portion of the hillside. The result of the catch as inspected this morning was as follows. Indicating only those captured.
