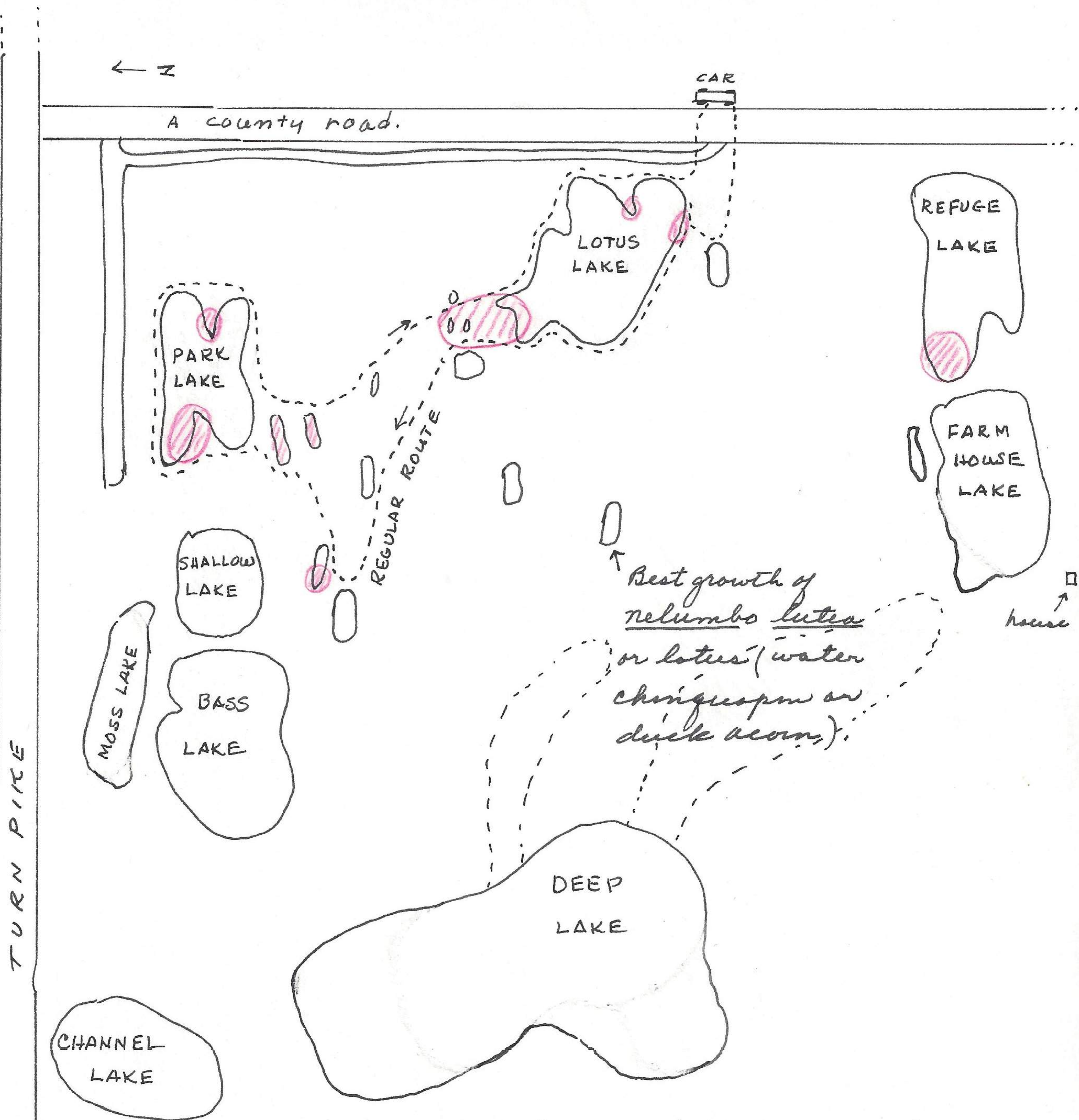


SANDPIT LAKES

This general area is designated as 1 7/10 mi N and 1 1/2 mi E Lawrence (P.O.), Douglas Co., Kansas. The regular route travelled is outlined. Sometimes other areas were visited (non-lake areas) for marsh wrens, rails and small sparrows. The usual flight of shorebirds was from Refuge Lake to Lotus, to Park and Shallow Lake. Most birds flew by the NW end of Lotus Lake. Areas in red were more frequently used by shorebirds than elsewhere. Refuge Lake was least disturbed because of off-limits to hunting and most ducks remained on this lake.
