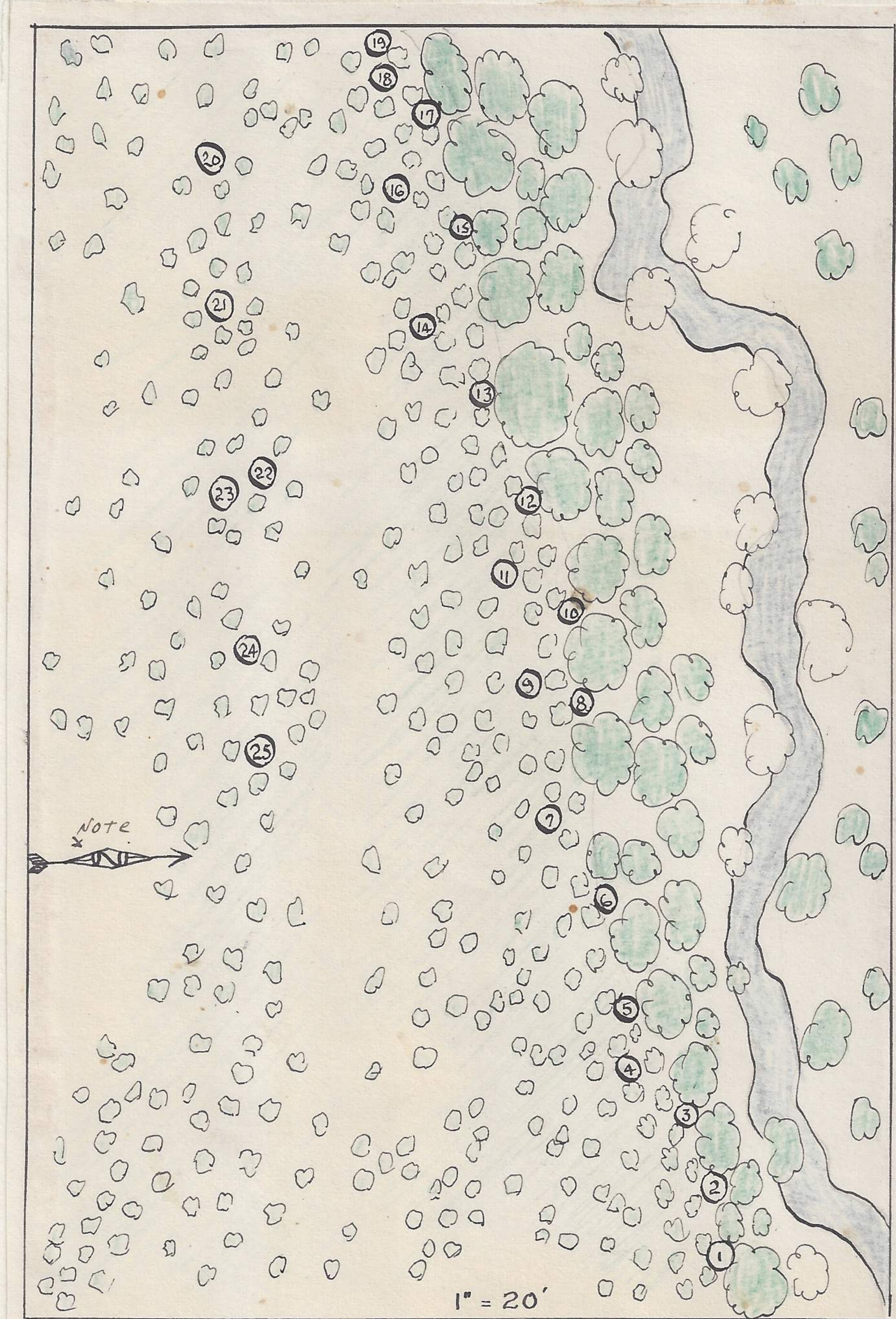


This trapping area produced the following from the same hole in the colony, Cottontail rabbit, Neotoma, marmot (seen in daytime), and Peromyscus taken near hole. One can only postulate as to what may go on under ground when the entire lot is congregated below. Set trap line this evening on delta at mouth of Grove Creek on south side.

6-14-37 (continued)

Inspected trap line set last night. This trap line is placed on the confluence of the sagebrush delta and the adjacent streamside habitat. The traps were set at the edge of the oak growth on bank of the delta. I had often wondered if the mammals could have used these vegetational contacts as thoroughfare. The results of the catch were negative but the results significant.

The sagebrush flat supported several cottontail and one or two jack rabbits. Cremodophrons were found in the same area as trap at edge of delta bank, especially among dry leaves of oak.
