



Temperature Chart for day. Two positions indicated on chart. This evening left Station 1 at 4:00 P.M. and hiked to spike camp at head of Grove Canyon. At the first spring on trail arrived 4:50 P.M. Its temperature was 55°F. Arrived at main stream crossover at head of canyon at 5:20 P.M. Its temperature = 51°F. The temperature of first creek east of crossing at 5:21 P.M. = 46°F. Arrived at spike camp = 5:30 P.M. Air temperature then = 56°F. Left on trap line at 5:38 P.M. and set line in a variegated habitat situation including (1) spring habitat, (2) supersaturated water course, (3) confining slopes. Area in general conforms to set-up of the night before. A. N. Thrush and 4 Cut umbellus (?) active while setting trap line. Found Indian artifacts around the springs. Back to camp at 7:30 P.M. Temperature then 50°F. Stars just coming out. Temperature at 8:20 = 50°F. Bed at 8:45 = 47°F. At 8:00 P.M. heard the poor-will calling.

Spike camp, head of Grove Cr. Canyon. Temp 43°F at 9:00 A.M. A. N. Thrush ceased calling at the arrival of the sun at camp spot at 9:15 A.M. but started up later. The results of this morning inspection of trap line are as follows:
