

Lynn, Miller, Dr Stanford of A.C. at Logan made trip to Hidden Lake Cirque. Tonight was to be our first night for trapping in the Cirque. On way up this morning collected the Hoary Bat that was found in identical place as of our trip on the 28<sup>th</sup>. Bat faced north. Snow bank had receded 92'. Arrived at Hidden Lake Cirque and established station 4 among large conifers at brink of cirque. I remained and set out trap line the first night. Traps set mainly among stunted conifers and varied situations,

7/3/37 (cont.)

Station 4 at Hidden Lake Cirque. Collected this morning the following.

Packed these well in among damp grasses and packed them down to Aspen Grove where I prepared them at station 3. Lowell Miller met me half way up trail this morning. He was to relieve me until tomorrow morning and carry on the trapping this evening.

7/4/37 (cont.)

Left Aspen Grove with stars still clear above. Arrived at Hidden Lake Cirque at sunrise. <sup>one</sup> Deer feeding on terraces. Lowell was just finishing trap route. He returned to Aspen while I made general observations and set trap line in evening. Yesterday at Aspen collected a Pygmy Owl and Flammulated Screech Owl. The Screech Owl came from Mule Flat from hole in aspen tree near census area of few days ago. The Pygmy owl came from conifers at Aspen Grove on south side of canyon. In the evening they come down to creek among the cottonwoods where the robins disclose their whereabouts by dashing madly at them from every angle. The evening robin disturbance started about the same time every evening. It was by following these robin disturbances that I was able to acquire 2 other Pygmies. One taken on the 6/30/37 and 7/1/37.

7/5/37 (cont.)

From the following inspection of trap line in Hidden Lake Cirque acquire the mammals. Traps set as of first night.
