Lynn Hayward and myself spent about a month in the field from July 16, 1937 to Aug. 12, 1937. The area to be trapped and investigated was in the main the Uintah mountains. Materials from this area were to be used for comparative purposes with our own Utah Co material. Several other geographical areas were investigated to tie in with the whole scheme of our problem. Our itinerary included the following: Provo, Heber, Strawberry reservoir, Duchesne, Myton, Roosevelt, Vernal, Jensen, Anasaur Natl monument, Douglas Cabin, Jensen, Vernal, highway to Green Lake, Greendale, Manda, Mc. Kinnon, Jonetree, Tynan, Fort Bridger, Carter, Fort Bridger, Evanston, Woodruff, Labelawn, Lakata, Bloomington, Paris, Sleep Lakes, hence to Provo via Logan.
