 alighted in top of a ponderosa pine at camp from the west.
 Two birds were shot from this flock, the others left but 6
 returned to the same tree and then left; 1:30 small flock
 heard flying & calling to the north of camp; 1:40 heard birds
 north of camp; 1:45 heard birds; 2:00 heard birds; 2:10
 six birds lit in ponderosa pine at camp, remained 2
 minutes and then left after their feeding; 2:12 heard
 birds; 3:00 two small flocks; 3:30 heard birds; 3:40
 heard birds; 3:55 heard birds; 4:00 heard birds; 5:10
 5 birds flying west

While at Elk Park observed the following birds:
 E. mt. chickadee; crossbills, Townsend solitaire, mountain
 bluebird; red-tailed hawk; gray-headed junco, red shafted flicker,
 hairy woodpecker, downy woodpecker, Clark crow, red-breast-
 ed nuthatch, white-breasted nuthatch, Audubon warbler,
 western evening grosbeak, nighthawk, Audubon hermit thrush,
 robin, western tanager, long-crested jay, chipping sparrow,
 owl sp?, red-naped sapsucker, ruby-crowned kinglet,
 black-tailed(?) hummingbird, pine siskin, mourning,
 dove, purple finch, Lincoln sparrow, purple finch, Brewer's
 blackbird, tree swallow, sparrow hawk.

Located a nest of the grey headed junco young. Nest
 10 feet from willow-lined stream in open meadow. Nest in
 small bush 5 inches above ground. This evening observed a
 western evening grosbeak feeding young on top of ponderosa
 pine. One flock of 40 ♂ + ♀ crossbills in one flock in
 mixed stand of ponderosa pine and aspen. Several
 nighthawks flying quite high this evening.

 large flock; 8:50 lone bird flying east; 9:00 heard birds;
 10:30 heard birds; 10:40 heard birds; 11:00 heard birds;
