

11:00 heard birds; 12:15 flock of approx 30 in ponderosa pine just east of camp. Collect 3. A female remain on a cone when after a male was shot 2 feet from her; 12:20 heard birds; 12:35 heard birds flying by; 12:40 heard birds flying by; 1:00 large flock passed by; 1:45 lone bird from west; 1:50 small flock east of camp; 1:55 small flock south of us; 3:00 heard birds; 3:40 heard birds flying overhead.

Elk Park, Uinta mountains, Utah

July 29, 1937

Continued census of crossbills from camp at Elk Park. First bird heard 5:00 A.M., 6:00 heard birds; 7:00 heard birds; 7:20 heard birds; 7:30 lone bird flying by; 7:40 heard birds; 7:50 heard birds; 8:00 2 birds perched in ponderosa pine at camp; 8:15 bird flew by [in field until 12:00 but heard birds occasionally]; 12:00 heard single bird flying by at camp; 12:05 5 birds flying by to east; 1:00 P.M. 8 alighted in tree at camp and remain 4 or 5 minutes while it rained during that period of time; 1:05 heard birds to the north; 1:30 heard birds; 1:40 heard birds; 2:00 heard birds; 2:45 large flock flew by; 3:30 heard birds flying by; 3:40 heard large flock; 4:30 heard birds; 5:30 heard birds; Unfavorable weather from 3:00 P.M. to 6:00

Elk Park, Uinta mountains, Utah

July 30, 1937

Continued observations on crossbills from camp. At day-break heard a large flock (about 6:00 A.M.); 6:30 heard birds; 7:00 2 birds flew by; 7:35 two birds flew by, one remained; 7:50 scattered flock flew by; 8:00 flock of 15; 8:15 group of 10 flew by; 8:20 flock of 10 flew by; 8:25 lone bird flew by; 8:30 30 birds feeding in ponderosa pine at camp [in field to 11:40]; 11:40 heard birds north of camp.

Elk Park, Uinta mountains, Utah

July 31, 1937

Left Elk Park and counted the number of *Collospermophilus* between here + Manila: 12. Camped at Fort Bridger.

Bear Lake, Idaho

Aug. 3, 1937

Camped at Bear Lake while Hayward visited family. Lynn showed me cabinet to be built for specimens.
