


Vivian Park, Utah Co., Utah. Geological pictures of overturned fold.

1-8/20/37. This fold is found on the north side of canyon about 2 blocks up Provo Canyon from where the south fork enters the main Provo River. It will be noted that the overturned strata angle off to the horizontal without a fault although it appears as if it does in the picture. The rocks are probably Pennsylvanian in age and support many Brachiopods and a few honey combed corals. 

2/8/20/37. Same as to left. Kiptone fault at top of exposure. This overturn is very noticeable in north fork of Provo Canyon. Probable Indian cave at base of the most conspicuous overturned stratum.

9/8/37

Trip to Donkey Lake on Aquarius Plateau. Visited many lakes and reservoirs west and adjacent to Donkey Lake Reservoir. Left Colton Ranch at Teasdale and packed in with equipment on Back. Collected a few ^(Sorex &) mammals near the Donkey Lake proper. but the original plan was for recreation and particularly for fishing. The fishing proved to be like a hatchery set-up with scores like 52 fish with 53 casts of the fly. Some fish ranged 18" long. Harry Thomas, Marcus Hitchcock, Ray Snow made trip with me. Victoria record only of our 5 day trip.
