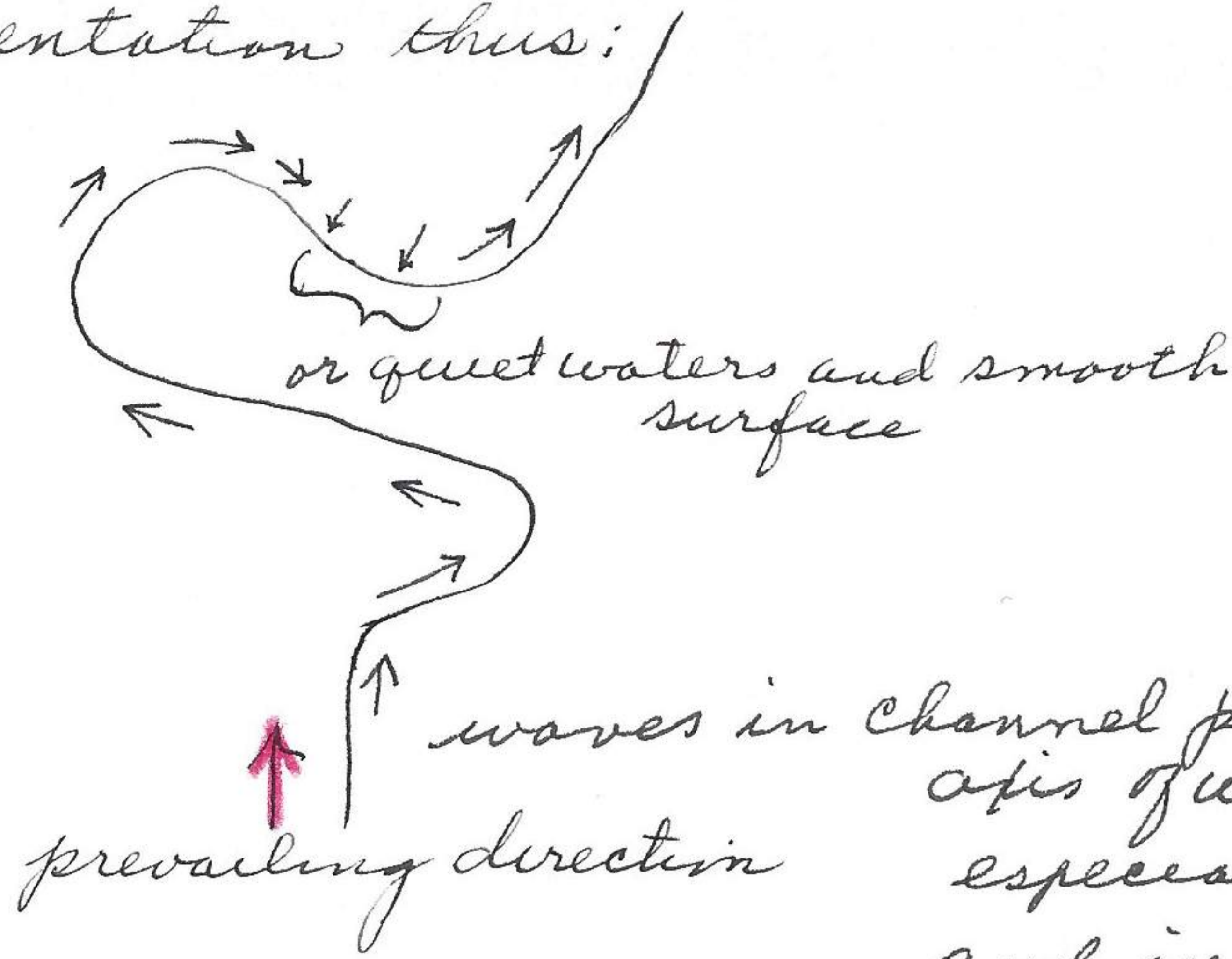


I have noticed that the wind conforms to channel orientation thus:
