ANIMALS AND BIRDS SEEN.

Bluebird. From the bridge crossing the Jordan River
to where road approaches mountain proper about
2 miles directly south of Mafffunders the bluebirds
were continually flying up from fence wires and
pole line in advance of the car, never a moment
without a bluebird incidence.

marsh hawk. Two marsh hawks seen along road
to collect mine & eagle canyon. One near Jordan
River the other on hillside south of Mafffunders.
One seen on return trip. No other hawk seen
except eagles & falcon.

Raven. Five seen at one time near eagle
canyon. Two were frequently seen in air and
no doubt nest in old cliffs over ridge north
of eagle nest. The raven spent their time in
either spiral rotations or coasting into wind.
Calling many times.

T. Saltator. Near eagle nest, one bird

Flicker. Heard near mouth of canyon leading
to eagle nest.

P. Siskin. One flock in eagle canyon.

S. E. Owl. One owl frightened from juniper about
1/2 way up canyon, another in same gulch as
eagle. Just as we started up canyon frightened
me from maples.

Chipmunk (sp.?) Only one seen on trip. It was
seen in rock slide area.

Blackbirds R.W. Several seen on road to Libi
and just out of Libi on way to Jordan River.
Mr. Mafffunders son says that the Pelicans
have not returned yet. Could not see
any from our advantageous viewpoint on
mt. side either.

Deer mule. 9 in no. at mouth of canyon
in maples and cedars. These deer were not
quite satisfied until a ridge was put between
them & the encroacher. No farmed members
also one dead deer that coyotes had completely
eaten. Found in main gulch about 1/2 way canyon
