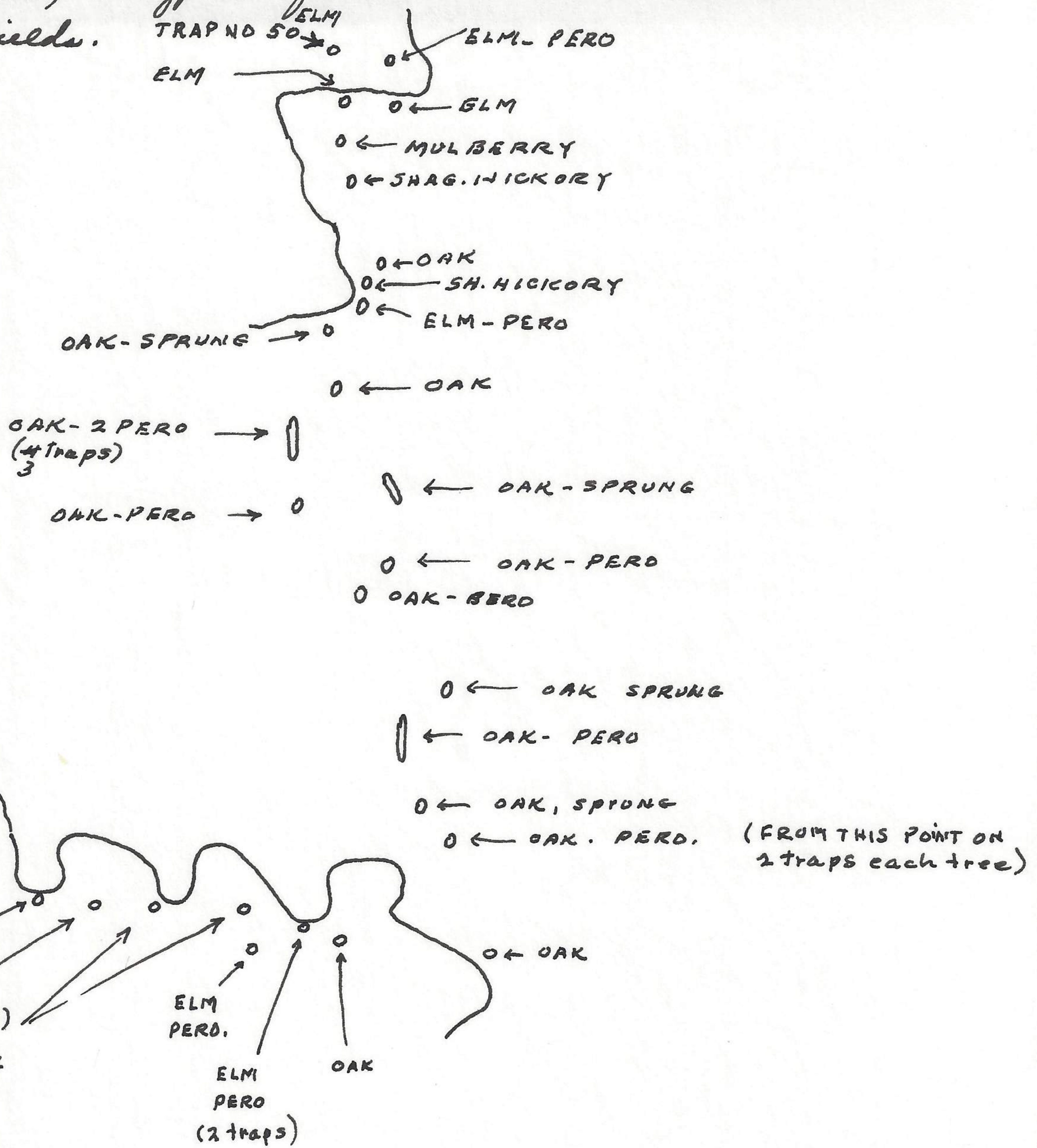


The 50 traps were placed at the base of the large trees (average diameter 3 feet) in typical forested area and at least 200 (some less) from fields.



The large oaks were black oaks. Birds observed this morning in field and forested area are (those marked with asterisks were observed along above trapline): Bell's vireo, robin, warbling vireo, mockingbird, dickcissel, meadowlark, purple martin, Eng sparrow, redheaded woodpecker, cowbird\*, catbird\*, black capped chickadee\*, m dove, common grackle, barn swallow, brown thrasher, acadian flycatcher\*, bluejay\*, bobwhite, field sparrow, chipping sparrow, swainson thrush\*, Baltimore oriole\*, goldfinch\*, redwing blackbird, eastern <sup>wood</sup> pewee\*, great-crested flycatcher\*, indigo bunting\*, chimney swift, downy woodpecker\*, hairy woodpecker\*, Kentucky warbler\*, parula warbler\*, carolina wren\*, starling.
