Indian and married a Wichita wife. He attended Haskell
College at Lawrence and attended Univ. Kansas where
he worked at the museum of Natural History. He had
paintings exhibited at many museums around the country.
This painting no 751209-1 is of an Indian who is
guardian of animals & birds. The guardian is always
riding a white elk and carries a stick and bag of
snakes. The characters associated are symbols of
the Delaware tribes when they lived in the eastern part
of the country and include: deer, whale, crow, track,
turtle, snake, wolf, ankings & bear. See medicine had
