

- 8:02 Two Virginia warblers singing in oak tops to right upon escarpment.
- 8:06. Swainson Hawk resting upon top of small oak on brink of valley to left. Flew when approached within 130'. Flew over edge & out of site.
- 6:08 Spurred Towhee to right singing.
- 6:10 Heard Humming bird flying by.
- 8:11 Heard Virginia Warbler to left of trail.
- 8:12 " " " chirping left.
- 8:14 " " " " " difficult to find.
- 8:14 Swainson lit in oak in same vicinity on edge of valley. flew when within 70'
- 8:14 2 Spurred Towhees to left. One feeding on ground the other following in limbs of oak. Both scolding.
- 8:16 3 White Cr. Sparrows feeding in trail about 30' ahead.
- 8:16 Mourning Dove resting on oak top on brink to left, flew at 60'
- 8:17 Pheasant calling and drumming
- 8:20 Leaving head of 1st valley and working around west edge to beginning of 2nd valley.
- 8:21 Pheasant calling in front followed by incomplete call.
- 8:25 Beginning up 2nd valley, can see top of N. side of Grove Creek.
- 8:26 Fresh deer tracks in trail.
- 8:26 Heard 2 spurred Towhees scolding and feeding in dry leaves on escarpment to right.
- 8:27 Spurred Towhee singing on brink of hill to left of trail.
- 8:27 Virginia Warbler chirping in oaks to right, one chasing the other across trail to oak on left side. One singing in oak below brink.
- 8:30 Mourning Dove Calling
- 8:31 Black & Grosbeak singing to left in oak top.
- 8:32 Virg. Warb. sing & feeding along tops of oak to right.
- 8:32 Spurred Towhee singing to right
- 8:34 Frightened 3 deer 100' in front near trail, they jumped to open & remained until opposite them they fled one stopping to take last look before clearing over edge of hill.
- 8:34. Pheasant calling & drumming as he worked progressively up this canyon.
- 8:36 Virginia Warbler singing on escarpment to right.
- 8:36 Spurred Towhee singing on high oak to right & ahead. Flew down when approached within 40'.
- 8:40 Humming bird flying west & calling.
- 8:40 G. T. Towhee feeding in lower brush under oaks.
- 8:42 Pheasant still calling & drumming as it works up canyon.
- 8:45 Flycatcher (?) in oaks
- 8:46 Chipping Sparrow on top of oak singing his locust like song.
- 8:47. Woodhouse Jay in high oak remaining still.
- 8:47 Chipping Sparrow flew into oak & then left toward escarpment.
- 8:50 Chipping Sparrow flew into top of high oak and sang his locust like song once every 16 sec. Passed by & he remained and continued to sing.
- 8:51 G. T. Towhee in large bush giving mewing call note, left & flew into base of oak stand.
- 8:52 Virginia Warbler lit in top of oak & sang then flew over to within 1 foot of Chipping Sparrow that was singing & inspected. Then flew to top of another oak & warbled for about 1 minute then flew away warbling while in the air.
- 8:56 G. T. Towhee flew to meet one observed (8:51)
- 8:57 Two Spurred towhees chasing one another in oak top 20' away.
