

- 12:47 Three Chipping Sparrows feeding on ground. Chirp mild and plaintive in contrast to Virginia
- 12:48 Heard Hummer. Summer wind blowing.
- 12:51 Virginia Warbler warbling on escarpment to the left
- 12:53 Two Spurred Towhees feeding together in dry grass & weeds at base of oaks. The oak stand was in a rather open clearing and when passing by they flew out and into nearby oak, scolding.
- 12:55 Virginia Warbler warbling on escarpment to left.
- 12:55 Near mouth of 2nd Canyon on flat portion of valley the large oak are drooping to the S.W.
- 12:56 Humming bud flying to the east & calling
- 12:56 Pheasant calling toward escarpment.
- 12:57 ♀ Pheasant flush near trail & lit 100' beyond.
- 12:59 Two G.T. Towhee & 1 Spurred Towhee flew up from some weed & oak growth as pheasant was frightened from.
- 12:59 4 Audubon Warblers in oak stand to right of trail, feeding near top branches, warning chip like Virginia warbler. The birds are more agile than Virginias a fluttering more when working in oak. Can approach them much easier than wing but when pressed to close will feed on ahead.
- 1:00 Arrived at mouth of second valley where valley leaves its N.W. S.E. trend & shoots abruptly down west exposure of range. Heard hummer & Woodhouse Jay. Leaves blowing on ground but skies clear, day bright & warm.
- 1:06 Jay lit on edge of flat.
- 1:07 Pheasant calling, Virginia Warbler warbling
- 1:12 Virginia warbler chirping near trail, when approached within 30' flew to escarpment and continued chirping in oak.
- 1:12 Grosbeak singing back in valley no 2.
- 1:13 Bright green beetle in trail (Tiger beetle)
- 1:13 Virginia warbler chirping on left, one singing 300' to left on escarpment.
- 1:15 Head of 1st valley. House Wren flew up from sage brush into oak 10' away and scolded. Two minutes later it began feeding at base of oaks and its vigorous scold changed to one of a muffled scold.
- 1:16 Spurred Towhee 20' down from wren, both to leave with crest in air.
- 1:16 Virginia Warbler chirping
- 1:17 " " warbling on left escarpment.
- 1:18 Coopers Hawk ^(?) flying through oak.
- 1:23 Humming bud flying east along escarpment.
- 1:24 Two Virginia Warblers singing on escarpment top to left.
- 1:24 Spurred Towhee scolding on escarpment 300' to left.
- 1:28 " " " to right
- 1:29 Two Spurred Towhees scolding on escarpment 200' apart.
- 1:30 7 or 8 Chipping Sparrows feeding on ground. One chased the other through oak.
- 1:30 sp. Towhee scolding 150' to escarpment. One Spurred Towhee feeding quietly and let me pass without objection.
- 1:31 Spurred Towhee scolding at base of tree 15' away.
- 1:35 One lone Audubon warbler feeding in top of oak.
- 1:36 End of 1st valley, Spurred Towhee singing 100 feet up on escarp. one 100 feet down hillside over brink of valley.
- 1:36 B.W. Grosbeak singing in same area as recorded this morning left tree on approach & disappeared.
- 1:37 Virginia warbler chirping 50' to south over bank.
- Good deer bedding grounds 100' up first canyon in floor of valley.
